The program is meant to encourage parents to continue to be the primary formators of their children's faith. The best instruction is by modeling the faith through daily prayer (focusing on the Act of Contrition this year and examining one's conscience), Sunday Mass attendance and regular family use of the Sacrament of Reconciliation (once monthly is recommended). Even if your children cannot yet receive, they will gain confidence and faith that Confession is not to be feared but is a sure way to experience God's mercy and grow in virtue and holiness.
